As a citizen and a supporter of the wilderness area in the Quetico-Superior National Forest, I protest the discriminatory action of the U.S.Forestry Service, Duluth, in condemning the property used by Miss Dorothy Molter on Knife Lake, while at the same time permitting the operation and expansion of a large business on Basswood Lake, not to mention those at Curtin and at Pipestone Falls.

If the avowed purpose is to maintain ' a wilderness area free of cabins and other vestiges of civilization ', then what is true for a single individual must surely be true for operators of a business with multiple buildings.

Such discriminatory action by a branch of the federal government should certainly warrant investigation by your office.
