Dear Miss Molter:

On receipt of your welcome letter of March 7, 1966, I transmitted it to the Regional Forester and recommended that every avenue be explored to effect the most equitable settlement possible.

The Regional Forester is very sympathetic to your situation and has only the highest regard for you. He is endeavoring to obtain fullest possible cooperation from the Office of the General Counsel and from Justice Department attorneys.

Any arrangements for compromise settlement prior to Court action are understood to be primarily the responsibility of the U.S. Attorney. I am hopeful that it may yet be possible to work out the terms of a mutually agreeable settlement.

I will immediately forward to you any pertinent information received here that concerns settlement terms for your land disposal case.
