Please refer to Nicolls' memo of 9/12/69. The lands people are trying to tie up a number of loose ends left dangling in some of our condemnation cases. The "loose ends" are in the form of outstanding certificates of title held by owners other than the U.S. on lands actually owned by the U.S.

In order to obtain issuance of a new certificate of title in such instances when the old one is not available, it is necessary to petition the court through the U.S. Attorney; and in some counties, hold a public hearing. When the existence and whereabouts of the old certificates are known, a great deal of time and expense is avoided by producing it upon request of a new certificate.

If you will be unable to see Miss Molter soon to obtain her certificate, please advise us as soon as possible as to when you can plan to do so.
