



## Visitor Face Mask Policy

The Dorothy Molter Museum requires all visitors over the age of 2 to wear a face mask covering their nose and mouth while on-site – indoors and outdoors.

*Disposable masks will be available for \$1.00 in the Gift Shop as well as reusable/washable KWITCHURBELIAKIN masks.*

For guests with a medical exemption for a face mask, a face shield is an acceptable alternative and must be worn at all times.

For visitors who cannot wear a face mask or face shield, the Museum may choose to make a reasonable accommodation based on the following:

- Decisions will be strictly case-by-case
- The visitor must have called the Museum directly and in advance with the request
- Accommodations will be considered for individuals with a diagnosed cognitive disability or developmental disorder such as autism spectrum disorder.
- Visitors must reserve the 4pm time slot (last tour of the day)
- No other visitors are already be registered

**Visitors are not allowed to have already registered, show up for their reservation and then request to not wear a mask or shield.**
